APPENDIX 3 Traffic Calming Measures

Residents continue to raise concern regarding drivers exceeding the 30mph speed limit on Melford Rd Melford Rd (entering and existing the village). Acton Speed Watch Members suggest that when the existing Parish owned Speed Indicator Device (SID) is periodically placed at Melford Rd it has a positive impact in reducing speed.

The proposal is to purchase a second SID which can be permanently sited at the Melford Rd end of the village. The exiting SID will be sited at the Waldingfield Rd end of the village. This project is supported by county councillor Philip Faircloth-Mutton who has offered a financial contribution from his locality budget.

Westcotec are the manufacturer and supplier of the Council's two existing Speed Indicator Signs and are recommended by Sudbury Town Council Community Wardens.

Costing Portable Speed Indicator Device (SID) with Smiley / Angry Face beneath, battery powered complete with spare Lead Acid battery, 'intelligent' charger, sign weatherproof cover and bracket set for a cost of £3,289.00 each excluding VAT.



Data Collection (Download via Bluetooth to your existing Android Device, running on 7.0 or newer version. App download required from Google Play Store) for a cost of £379.00 per sign excluding VAT.

Comprehensive THREE-YEAR WARRANTY which covers everything except vandalism, impact damage, theft and batteries. Batteries include the manufacturer's ONE-year warranty.

Total Cost £3,668.00 excluding VAT, to be funded 50% Neighbourhood CIL Fund and 50% County Councillor Highways Locality Budget.

Acton Parish Council purchased one of these signs last year, research for alternative suppliers was carried out and it was concluded that the Westcotec units are the best option for the council. As mentioned above STW also have experience of alternatives but recommend staying with UK manufactured Westcotec.

APPENDIX 4 Acton Wildlife Reserve Equipment

Cllr Round and Cllr Le Gry

The Volunteer Team have been using the ride-on lawnmower tractor for maintenance cutting back work at the wildlife reserve. This machine is not suited to this type of work and does not clear vegetation growth. The machine will deteriorate fast if it continues to be used in this way. The correct machine for maintaining the vegetation is a brush cutter (see below). There are many differences between a brush cutter and a lawnmower.

It is proposed that the Council should purchase a **Orec Rabbit RM830 Ride-on Brush Cutter 82cm Cut £6,749.00 excl VAT** Cheap Mowers UK, from Acton's Neighbourhood CIL fund.

This machine model is ideal for use at the Reserve and gives good value for money with a local warranty and service agents based in Sudbury. Acton Wildlife Reserve is an important public amenity, this replacement machine will greatly aid with volunteer maintenance of the site. During the growing seasons the brush cutter will need to be used to keep the pathways cut every 2-3 weeks.

Cllrs Le Gry and Round will carry out a risk assessment and issue operator training instructions. When not in use the equipment will be locked and the keys will not be handed to any non-trained persons.

Comprehensive online research has led us to select this particular make and size of brush cutter. Similar prices have been quoted by other suppliers. A comparable product which could be £450 cheaper but it can only be obtained from a Europe based supplier which is not satisfactory for ongoing warranty and service issues. Cheap Mowers UK are the preferred supplier because they offer a Sudbury based service provider for ongoing maintenance.

For information, an online blogger's cost comparison is extracted below. Not all of the products are comparable with the Orec and this assessment is older than the online research recently carried out by Cllrs Round and Le Gry.
